Records of officers being considered for competitive promotions are forwarded to the appropriate promotion board once a year. Officers may be promoted to both the temporary and permanent assistant (LTJG, O-2) and senior assistant (LT, O-3) grades following an administrative review as the controlling dates are reached; medical officers may also be promoted to the temporary full (LCDR, O-4) grade on a similar basis. Promotions to all higher grades are competitive.

c/ Time in current tour of duty must be met as of March 1 of the year in which the record is reviewed.
